- ✓ It was suggested that meeting dates be selected so everyone who wants to, can put it on their calendar and make arrangements well in advance to attend. Engineering Information

- ✓ The annual district engineering competition will be held at NHS, April 2, 2016. Only 5 schools are competing this year. (Probably because we changed the day from a school day with unbearable time constrictions because other schools get out early and we start late; to a Saturday.) We expect enrollment to be much better next year. This year is also the first year that elementary students will participate. They began building their cars last Wednesday and will sand and paint over spring break and finish the Wednesday after spring break just in time to participate. This is held in the gym and the practice field off of 39th street. We will be selling concessions, Bonnie and Hedi will buy the materials, coffee, donuts and chips and bring them. Head count will be about 50 and each student will get two slices of pizza. Mr. Handler will get organizational information from Jamie Ramos and forward it to us.
- ✓ The Annual Plywood Regatta will be held at Dania Beach on April 9th & 10th this year. We have three teams competing from NHS. It is sponsored by the Marine Industry Association of South Florida (MIASF). The students who participate are given lunch money to support MIASF fundraising (they sell the lunches there). Parents are asked to arrive early, 7:30a-8:00a to secure parking and bring snacks (signup sheet was passed around and is

listed below). On April 10th after the competition, and awards ceremony, the End of Year Engineering BBQ will be held at the Osprey Pavilion at John Lloyd Park. There are currently 110 members of the engineering club so it was decided to purchase 125 hot dogs and 125 hamburgers and buns and correlating paper products. We will ask parents to bring their own drinks, and to bring side dishes such as potato salad, baked beans, Cole slaw chips, mustard, ketchup etc., as well as, desserts such as brownies, cookies, cakes, pies...etc. Hedi Gadelrab will purchase the meat, buns and paper products from Restaurant Depot.

- ✓ White cords – Mr. Handler suggested charging \$10 each for seniors white cords that indicate the passing of an industry certification. Those in attendance felt that this can be done starting next year, not this year when it was not an expectation set at the beginning of the school year. Kathryn Mehaffey made a motion to set aside \$500 to fund the white cords for this school year and if the costs exceed that, then students will pay the difference. Hedi Gadelrab assured us that there was enough money in the account to cover that. Katy O'Hara seconded the motion and the motion was carried unanimously.

*****An update since the meeting was that Mr. Handler had some white cords left over from last year and we only needed to purchase 25 at \$8 each for a total of \$200. Amanda Muir placed the order from Herf Jones which has them in stock and set them aside. Hedi Gadelrab will go by with a check and pick them up in the next week or so.

Swimming/Water Polo information

- ✓ Parents have been donating drinks and snacks to a concession stand at all home water polo games. All of this money has been given to coach to put into internal accounts.
- ✓ Senior Night is coming up. It will be held at NHS immediately following the March 30th game against Pines Charter School. Expenses should not be more than \$100. Picture developing, frames, miniature water polo balls, piñata and candy are among the items that will be presented to the seniors.
- ✓ We need to know the balance from coach in internal accounts and how much in Buca gift cards are left to go towards the end of the year luncheon.
- ✓ It was suggested that we use the existing cards and purchase more if needed from Costco where you can get \$100 worth of gift cards for \$79.99.
